

Three Rivers Youth Football Parent's Code of Conduct

Parents of players are asked to abide by a Code of Conduct which includes the following Provisions:

1. There will be no smoking on the field at games or practices.
2. Do not criticize players in front of other players. Constructive criticism is the coach's responsibility. If you feel the coach has overlooked something speak to him/her in private.
3. Accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair and called to the best of the ability of said official.
4. Do not criticize opposing coaches, players or fans by gestures or comments.
5. Emphasize that winning is the result of hard play and teamwork.
6. Refrain from the use of profanity and abusive language.
7. Do not permit ineligible players to participate in practices or games.
8. Do not deliberately incite un-sports-man-like conduct.
9. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the fields or in the stands during games or practices. Do not come to games or practice sessions under the influence of alcoholic beverages and or mind altering drugs.
10. Coaches and game officials are jointly responsible for the conduct of the team, fans and spectators. Any fan that becomes a nuisance or acting in an unbecoming way will be asked to leave!

Zero Tolerance

Three Rivers Youth Football has ZERO TOLERANCE for parents or spectators that would interfere with games or practices in an unruly manor or whose actions disrupt games or practices. During a game if a parent or spectator's actions are deemed by the referee as inappropriate, the head coach will be notified to get the parent or spectator's actions under control. If the action occurs again, a 15-yard penalty will be imposed on the team. If the action continues, the game will be suspended immediately with teams returned to their sidelines and the police will be called to remove the parent or spectator from the premises.
